## Materials Needed:

Dress form print: 1 yard  
Chair print: 1 yard  
Lining: 1 yard  
Pom poms 1 1/2 yards  
Fusible fleece: 3/4 yard


## Cutting:

Dress form print: 2 - 15 1/4" x 11 1/2" pieces  
Chair print: 2 - 8 1/4" x 11 1/2" pieces  
Lining: 1 - 23" x 31" piece  
Pom poms: 48"  
Fusible fleece: 1 - 23" x 31" piece

## Step by Step

### Create the outside:

1. Place a chair piece and dress form piece together, right sides facing.
2. Sew together using a 1/4" seam allowance.
3. Press the seams open.
4. Repeat steps 1 - 3 for the other dress form/chair pair. However, if you sewed the dress forms to the right, on the last one, sew them to the left on this pair. (i.e.: You will end up with a mirrored pair of front and back panels.)
5. Place the two finished panels right sides together.
6. Leaving the bottom open, sew together the top and side seams using a 1/4" seam allowance.
7. Press the seams open.
8. With the piece still inside out, align one side seam with a top seam so they are face to face with one another. This creates a triangle shape at the corner.
9. Measure 3" from the tip of the triangle and draw a line across. See figure 1.
10. Sew along the line, then cut off the excess fabric.
11. Repeat steps 8 - 10 for the other side.
12. Fuse the fleece to the wrong side.



### Create the lining:

1. Fold the lining in half the long way with right sides facing.
2. Sew the sides of the lining from the top to the bottom using a 1/4" seam allowance, leaving the bottom open as well as a 4" opening toward the bottom of one of the sides for turning.
3. Press the top fold so it is visible.
4. Repeat steps 7 - 11 above to complete the lining.

### Put the pieces together:

1. Place the outside into the lining with the right sides facing.
2. Align the seams and pin the pieces together.
3. Sew together all the way around the bottom of the cover.
4. Turn and press.
5. Sew the pom pom fringe onto the bottom of the cover.
